DELEGATE EMANUEL: I would subscribe to the present provision of the Constitution.

THE CHAIRMAN: You would keep the clergy out?

SENATOR HUGHES: Also on vacancies, first you have to decide whether it should remain in the same party, I think therefore the committees who are elected by the people in the county or the district are the bodies that guide the representation and should be the one that make the recommendation and their recommendation should be followed, because they are going to be a lot closer to the people that are going to be represented by this person than the Governor is.

So, I like the present provision.

DELEGATE MOORE: I agree with that provision.

THE CHAIRMAN: Does anyone else want to comment on that one?

SENATOR JAMES: I have a rather strong feeling about that. However, I think John Hardwicke made a good point when he said if I man dies in the first or second year of a four-year term, certainly people are entitled
