2 THE CHAIRMAN: Would you amplify that?

3 DELEGATE MOORE: How?

4 DELEGATE MANDEL: It's very simple. You can
5 establish citizenship and go down and live in Florida
6 and maintain your residency there.

7 MR. HARVEY: They have both, citizenship and
8 residing for three years. So, that takes care of it.

9 DELEGATE KIRCHER: I can't see anyone having
10 that much money, moving to Florida all the time and run-
11 ning back.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: In the provision for the Govern-
13 or, it is worded differently. Would you keep this same
14 requirement, three and one, or would you require someone
15 to run for office who lived in Maryland only one year
16 instead of -- we've got a lot of mobility.

17 DELEGATE MANDEL: I'd make it at least two.

18 SENATOR HUGHES: I don't find fault with three,
19 but at least two.

20 DELEGATE HARDWICKE: The legal format has
21 been here one year and intends to be here permanently.
