That's the legal concept. That may be all right. 1 other words, does he intend to stay here and make his 2 home here? 3 THE CHAIRMAN: All right, let's get to the other point. Would you continue the requirement of 5 residence of one year in the legislative district or 6 county, with the knowledge now that the county or 7 district is not necessarily the key locus for repre-8 sentation? It is not necessarily. I am not passing 9 judgment as to whether it should be. 10 SENATOR HUGHES: This would be a problem in 11 changing the districts around. 12 SENATOR JAMES: I would think six months would 13 be plenty for the district in which he seeks to represent 14 MR. HARVEY: What about leaving it up to the 15 voters and letting him run from anywhere? 16 THE CHAIRMAN: That's true for Congress. 17 SENATOR JAMES: I have no objection. 18 THE CHAIRMAN: You have no objection to 19 knocking out the county residence requirement? 20 SENATOR JAMES: No. 21
