Massachusetts can run for the Senate in New York. 1 think that's a bad setup. I agree with Narvin. 2 DELEGATE EMANUEL: You came close to having 3 Wallace here. DELEGATE KIRCHER: Many sections of the 5 Constitution say it should be compact and contiguous. However, putting all these things together, the representative can come from the other end of town or the 8 other end of the State, and I don't think it follows. 9 I think it would be contradictory. I think if you're 10 going to make them compact, contiguous and get a unanimity 11 of interest, you should have a representative from that 12 district. 13 DELEGATE MANDEL: I think a representative 14 should be available to the people he represents. 15 this is very important. He should be right available to 16 those people and, if you had a man in Baltimore County, 17 for example, elected in Baltimore City, I think that 18 availability stops at that point. 19
