

1 Massachusetts can run for the Senate in New York. I
2 think that's a bad setup. I agree with Marvin.

3 DELEGATE EMANUEL: You came close to having
4 Wallace here.

5 DELEGATE KIRCHER: Many sections of the
6 Constitution say it should be compact and contiguous.
7 However, putting all these things together, the repre-
8 sentative can come from the other end of town or the
9 other end of the State, and I don't think it follows.
10 I think it would be contradictory. I think if you're
11 going to make them compact, contiguous and get a unanimity
12 of interest, you should have a representative from that
13 district.

14 DELEGATE MANDEL: I think a representative
15 should be available to the people he represents. I think
16 this is very important. He should be right available to
17 those people and, if you had a man in Baltimore County,
18 for example, elected in Baltimore City, I think that
19 availability stops at that point.

20 THE CHAIRMAN: Does it sometimes lead to
21 gerrymandering, when you have to redistrict to keep them
