THE CHAIRMAN: How about persons holding 1 military office? That's in that same question. 2 DELEGATE MANDEL: I've never understood the 3 reason for that. 4 MR. ENEY: It's goes back to historical 5 reasons, the fear of the military, civilian control of 6 the military. 7 SENATOR JAMES: I know reserve officers can 8 serve. 9 DELEGATE KIRCHER: Some of our reserve offi-10 cers and also National Guard people. 11 THE CHAIRMAN: The interpretation is that they 12 are not fully active officers. 13 SENATOR JAMES: I think that could be quali-14 fied some. 15 DELEGATE HARDWICKE: Historically speaking, 16 I think keeping the military out of the legislature is 17 very well founded, if you go back to Napoleon's time and 18 THE CHAIRMAN: Perhaps the word active should 19 be put in there, so no one has any guilt feelings about 20 being in the reserves. 21
