provision. 1 DELEGATE MANDEL: I think if there is any 2 constitutional way to do it, if you can use registered 3 voters as a basis, I think you would solve your problem without any trouble. 5 THE CHAIRMAN: The courts in Baltimore ruled against that. 7 DELEGATE MANDEL: The Supreme Court said it's 8 all right in Hawaii. 9 THE CHAIRMAN: Yes, but it isn't all right 10 under certain circumstances. 11 DELEGATE MANDEL: If it can be used, I think 12 this is the one way you can determine any day in the week 13 what your population basis is. 14 THE CHAIRMAN: Incidentally, who would do the 15 reapportionment and redistricting? Would you have the 16 legislature do it? 17 SENATOR JAMES: What does Alaska do? Doesn't 18 the Governor do it, with an advisory condition? 19 THE CHAIRMAN: In some of the states. 20 model says the Governor should do it with an advisory 21
