THE CHAIRMAN: You would put that in the 1 Constitution? 2 SENATOR JAMES: Yes. 3 DELEGATE HARDWICKE: Give them an expression 4 on the State census, if you don't mind. Every two years 5 or whatever period they make think proper. 6 THE CHAIRMAN: Are we saying, from what I 7 gather, John, the consensus seems to be every ten years 8 rather than two; is that right? 9 DELEGATE MANDEL: If the term is four years, 10 what are you going to do? 11 THE CHAIRMAN: Unless you have a staggered 12 system --13 DELEGATE KIRCHER: Suppose we do it every 14 ten years, alternating with the Federal Government. 15 Mat way, every five years there would be a census. 16 THE CHAIRMAN: You would certainly have to 17 set up procedure for actually gathering the census. 18 Some of us who have been working at this know it is 19 murder to get it.
