

1 THE CHAIRMAN: You would put that in the
2 Constitution?

3 SENATOR JAMES: Yes.

4 DELEGATE HARDWICKE: Give them an expression
5 on the State census, if you don't mind. Every two years
6 or whatever period they make think proper.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Are we saying, from what I
8 gather, John, the consensus seems to be every ten years
9 rather than two; is that right?

10 DELEGATE MANDEL: If the term is four years,
11 what are you going to do?

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Unless you have a staggered
13 system --

14 DELEGATE KIRCHER: Suppose we do it every
15 ten years, alternating with the Federal Government.
16 That way, every five years there would be a census.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: You would certainly have to
18 set up procedure for actually gathering the census.
19 Some of us who have been working at this know it is
20 murder to get it. All right, let's have this final
