DR. BURDETT: November 15th, for Harford County 1 and October, for Contemporary Local Government in Maryland 2 MR. RATCHFORD: They are still current. MR. BROOKS: Are those single volume works. each report a single volume? 5 MR. RATCHFORD: Yes, sir. 6 MR. BROOKS: A paperback that we could perhaps 7 get for distribution? 8 MR. RATCHFORD: Well, I defer to Dr. Burdett 9 on that point. 10 DR. BURDETT: You can get Contemporary Local 11 Government in Maryland, but you will be limited in the 12 number of copies for Harford County, since this was an 13 individual report.
