Hammond's opinions. If we don't agree with these 1 estimates, and we do disagree with them from time to time, 2 we have to stick to the formula for the amount under the 3 population estimate, but I believe we could reduce their request if we didn't agree with their population estimates 5 6 and so stated. I didn't realize that. 7 THE CHAIRMAN: MR. RENNIE: This is one of the --8 THE CHAIRMAN: Because that does give you, in 9 fact, the power to change their budget. When the State 10 Board of Education submits a budget, it has those population 11 figures in there. They are the multipliers, really --12 MR. RENNIE: That's right. They are very 13 particular. They have been caught a couple of times 14 being conservative, and they are very particular on this, 15 and I would say for all practical purposes that is a manda 16 tory item. We haven't had occasion to change their popula 17 18 tion estimates --MR, SLICHER: Their Statistical Department 19 does a pretty good job on these estimates, and because of 20 our limited ability time-wise to get figures of this type, 21
