14 budget shall have the power, and it shall be his duty, to  
15 require from the proper State officials, including herein  
16 all executive departments, all executive and administrative  
17 offices, bureaus, boards, commissions and agencies, ex-  
18 pending or supervising the expenditure of, and all  
19 institutions applying for State monies and appropriations,  
20 such itemized estimates and other information, in such form  
21 and at such times as he shall direct." Now, that part is
