1 concerned, following the question to its conclusion, we 2 have had very little difficulty with the legislature. As a matter of fact they try to keep theirs as low as they can and then finagle, if they need some more money for something, rather than go in with too large a budget. 5 MR. BROOKS: Who prepares their budget? MR. SLICHER: It is done by the speaker and 8 President. MR. BROOKS: They literally prepare it themselves 10 MR. RENNIE: And they do sit down with us. 11 MR. SLICHER: They go over it with us. 12 MR. RENNIE: We do the spadework for them. 13 print up the budget request sheets from the departments, 14 and we have so many copies of them.
