1 divisions and supporting services of the Courts." 2 MR. BOND: Can I interrupt? Assuming complete home rule, those offices would revert back to the local 3 4 subdivisions, would they not? 5 MR. BENTON: No, not necessarily the Courts. 6 THE CHAIRMAN: In other words, you are opposed to any supplementation to any judges' salaries? 7 8 MR. BENTON: I'11 get to that in a moment. 9 I am. 10 "In some instances, such as the Board of Liquor 11 License Commissioners, present State law requires the City 12 of Baltimore to appropriate whatever expenditures are 13 certified to us. Under this system, the operations of 14 such departments are not subject to the organization and 15 management analyses that are exercised by the State Bureau 16 of the Budget in reference to the State offices supported 17 by State funds, nor can they be subjected to the City's 18 budgetary provisions, as the City has no control or 19 authority over the operations. In making this recommendation 20 I am cognizant of the fact that the implementation may re-21 quire some adjustment in State-local finances.
