

1 THE CHAIRMAN: But you get \$4 for each
2 conviction, no matter whether --

3 MRS. MARGARET KOSTRITSKY: No.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: That's what I was told just
5 yesterday.

6 MRS. KOSTRITSKY: There is an assessment for
7 \$4 via Criminal Court. In Traffic Court, the Court costs
8 assessed is \$1, at the present time.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: What I am talking about is the
10 State.

11 MRS. KOSTRITSKY: No, that is applicable only
12 to the counties.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: Wait a minute. The State
14 Department of Motor Vehicles remits to Baltimore City a
15 certain part of the fines, motor vehicle fines.

16 MR. BENTON: Yes. This is to reimburse us, up to,
17 I think it's \$60,000 for the cost of the six judges. That
18 is what it was at one time. Whether it has been increased

19 THE CHAIRMAN: You better check with the
20 Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, because they think they do.
21 They send you a check.
