

1 the subdivisions in the adjustment of such licenses in
2 relation to other fees and charges, in relation to costs
3 generally, and in relation to the needs of the subdivision.
4 Secondly, the present system, in my judgment, is inefficient
5 in that an elected Court Clerk is responsible for the
6 collection of such license fees, whereas the City and other
7 subdivisions in their respective collection offices could,
8 in many instances, collect and issue such licenses with a
9 minimum of additional personnel."

10 Further, on the State administration, the City is
11 required to extend itself to make sure the remittances are
12 what they should be and the same offices are audited by the
13 State Auditor.

14 "It is, therefore, recommended that the State
15 be precluded from the levying of any taxes, charges, fees
16 and licenses which are primarily local in nature, and re-
17 serve such right to the local jurisdiction. It is not
18 intended that this should inhibit the State in passing
19 whatever regulatory legislation it deemed appropriate, but
20 the power to regulate is not necessarily inclusive of the
21 power to attach charges for the purpose of producing
