revenue. This statement is not intended to apply to fees
that are charged by the State, for services such as the
University of Maryland, University Mospital, which are
designed to defray the cost incurred in the area of
licensing, such as the charge for a driver's permit or the
charge for taking a Bar examination and things of that nature

"In summary, therefore, it is recommended that there be a constitutional prohibition against the State imposing fees, charges, licenses, or taxes which are primarily local in character without regard to whether they are imposed for local purposes, and which should be reserved to the local political subdivisions.

"Over a year ago, the City of Baltimore realized that a great deal of research was necessary in the area of local financing of State offices and services, particularly in the area of the Courts. We were most fortunate at that time in obtaining the services of a Mrs. Margaret Kostritsky, who is here with us this morning. It is my understanding that Mrs. Kostritsky has been working with the Constitutional Convention Commission in furnishing source material and otherwise assisting in the marshalling of the necessary
