HOFFMAN: One might even think that primarily local might be those for which the State doesn't find it necessary to have State-wide licensing. If the State 5 doesn't license and it's --6 MR. BENTON: If one takes a few minutes to refer 7 to these documents that I just made reference to, they will 8 find them very, very amusing. 10 MR. BOND: I agree with your premise, but I'm worried -- suppose everybody agreed we want it in the 11 Constitution.. I'm worried about the verbiage. 12 MR. BENTON: This is something that needs to be 13 studied, I agree. 14 THE CHAIRMAN: Janet, do you have a statement? 15 MRS. HOFFMAN: I would like to subscribe to Mr. 16 Benton's statement, and I wanted to treat a further subject 17 matter, the property taxation. It is no secret that 18 property is the main stay of local government at the moment 19 20 and local government is the level of government where the greatest projected increase in expenditures exists. 21
