them, especially during the time when the legislature is not in session.

One way to accomplish this flexibility is to provide a governmental emergency fund which is an appropriation that can be utilized on the signature of the Governor and the legislative leaders stating their intent to recommend to the next legislature a deficiency appropriation to replace the money. This same type of technique can be used to cover situations for Federal money coming in, where you don't actually need cash, dollars, but you need authority to spend it, and if the Governor and the legislative leaders sign such a statement you would be able to use additional monies from outside sources.

I think such a system would insure that the authorizations to use such monies would never be lost and that the Governor and the legislature and, most important, the public would have the full picture in making decisions on the taxing and expenditure of public monies.

I think such a constitutional provision would have another very desirable effect, in that all monies would be swept into a comprehensive system of expenditure.
