legislation as to our cabinet type of Governor and, as 1 I recall, John, we don't specify the departments. We say 2 there will be so many, ten, twelve, different departments 3 set up under the Governor which would go right into what 4 Mr. Lauber and you were discussing. I don't think we 5 are going to sit down and specify which departments, al-6 though there has been suggested that the Constitution 7 actually spell out the departments. 8 I don't think we are going to go for that, but 9 it has been suggested. So, we are moving in that direction. 10 DR. JENKINS: Who are the we you are referring 11 12 to? MR. BOND: This is the Committee on Executive 13 Department. My only question is, Mr. Lauber, you say the 14 legislature must not be hampered on acting on the budget. 15 The Governor has to present a balanced budget. There is no 16 responsibility on the legislature. If they have unhampered 17 authority, they can spend it and they don't have to say 18 where it's going to come from. That is why I disagree with 19 your statement on that. 20 MR. LAUBER: This is true. It is always possible.
