4 was the Chairman of this, I believe; but John has done a  
5 great deal of work on the Maryland Budget, which is his  
6 business, analyzing and installing new systems of govern-  
7 ment and I'm glad you have come up, John, to tell us  
8 whether or not there is anything that ought to be done,  
9 in your judgment, with respect to the budget, since you  
10 were last advising a State agency back in 1950.

11 DR. JENKINS: This resulted in the adoption of  
12 the program budget.

13 MR. DONAHO: That's correct.

14 THE CHAIRMAN: That's right. So, the floor is  
15 yours, my friend.

16 MR. DONAHO: Thank you, Dick. I don't suppose  
17 I need to give any further pedigree. I might mention that  
18 I have personally been involved, in not only in the over-all  
19 budget of Maryland, but for North Carolina, South Carolina,  
20 Alaska, Arizona, Hawaii, Mississippi, California, Oregon,  
21 Ohio, and a consultant in New York and a few other places.
