I do think that home rule should be broad with respect to 1 any local government and I would like to say again that I 2 am most grateful to you and to your Committee for per-3 mitting me to be with you today and I certainly would be willing to assist in any way possible at any time in the 5 future. 6 7 THE CHAIRMAN: Thank you very much. Dr. Loevy? DR. LOEVY: Could I just ask you one question 8 9 before you go, for a point of information? MR. THOMPSON: Yes, sir. 10 11 DR. LOEVY: There has been some talk in the 12 Committee of eliminating all cities and making Baltimore County a home rule county; in other words, having just 13 twenty-four units of local government, twenty-three 14 counties and Baltimore City as a county. As a principal 15 spokesman for the municipalities in Maryland, what do you 16 think of this idea? 17 MR. THOMPSON: I would think that it would be-18 quite unlikely that a satisfactory solution to the prob-19 20 1ems of local government in the State of Maryland would
