University of Washington, he said I was attempting to 1 perpetrate upon that State a new concept of public adminis-2 tration, namely that there were three branches in the 3 government; and I said, well, I had examined the government of the State of Washington and I found out to my satisfac-5 tion that there were three branches of the government and 6 that I did not find the University of Washington the 7 judicial branch, nor did I find it in the legislative 8 branch and, therefore, I could only conclude it was in the executive branch and, therefore, I assume that the 10 institutions of higher learning and the public school 11 people are in the executive branch. 12

I assume also, I think with some correctness, that is probably where the people would like to see them remain, unless you want to go the California route and create a fourth branch of the government, and this I advise you against. Now, if you do decide to permit the General Assembly to increase the Governor's budget, then you've got to give him corresponding authority to allot. I don't think you want to leave this to his inherent constitutional prerogatives, unless you are going to have as strong a

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
