tenet for a balanced budget. People are always saying to me, we have a balanced budget in Maryland, It must 2 be part of the law. 3 MR. BOND: This is not specifically the language. MR. DONAHO: That's right. It's been there so 5 long, people think it's in there. When I came to the State 6 in 1952, I was surprised people never read the Constitution 7 The Constitution always says there should be twenty-one 8 departments and no more, and a few other things. I found 9 out the Attorney General's office hardly ever read the 10 Constitution. So, I think it's worthwhile being very 11. 12 explicit. MR. BOND: Mr. Donaho, just one minute. I'm not 13 as dumb as I thought. It does say that the Governor --14 the budget shall contain a complete plan of proposed 15 expenditures and estimated revenues for said fiscal year 16 and shall show the estimated surplus or deficit of revenues 17 at the end of the preceding fiscal year. 18 How would you clarify that line? 19 MR. DONAHO: The budget must be balanced as to 20

revenues and expenditures.
