2 MR. DONAHO: That is what he says, that they
3 can't estimate.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: And they blame it on Albert
5 Ward.

6 MR. LAUBER: That's right, because if he is
7 caught short, the other way, he is going to be in a
8 terribly embarrassing position.

9 MR. DONAHO: They will never get caught short.

10 MR. LAUBER: I think if you look at the New
11 York budget, you will find they estimate cash expenditures
12 and estimate it very tightly. It doesn't matter if they
13 are 5,000,000 over or under because it can be balanced out
14 through this fund, and that is the honest estimate, the
15 best possible estimate how much cash is going to be spent.
16 They can commit \$100,000,000 and estimate they are going
17 to spend 98,000,000.

18 MR. DONAHO: The problem is not to get the
19 Constitution involved -- take the things the Feds are
20 yapping about. You've got the administrative budget, the
21 cash budget and they refer to Paul Douglas who wants to
