13 MR. BROOKS: No.

14 MR. DONAHO: I'll tell you what brought this  
15 up. Going to the seventy-day session, instead of having  
16 the short session, because you get an awful lot of stuff  
17 backed up behind the budget bill; but, fine. So what?  
18 This keeps them moving on the budget bill. Otherwise,  
19 they would use this device to blackjack the Governor. That s  
20 why I think you ought to have also a device in there to  
21 make the damn thing become effective on a certain date.
