that Lauber touched on, namely Section 1 of Article 3. 1 I call these sections, but they are really not 2 Section 52. 3 sections. Section 1? THE CHAIRMAN: MR. DONAHO: Yes, concerning the definition of 5 the treasury. We have been very fortunate in Maryland, that 6 the treasury, largely because we are an old State and that 7 the State was here, well, the colony was here and the State 8 before there was a Federal Government, but if you could see what happens in the Western States, you would just be 10 horrified, not only in terms of special funds, but in terms 11 12 of Federal funds. Also, we do not have this constant Federal 13 interference in Maryland that you get in western legislatures 14 where every time you turn around, you're getting a telegram 15 from the Secretary of Labor or the Secretary of HEW, saying 16 you can't do this because they are much interested in 17 maintaining the special funds concept, including Federal 18 funds and, as you know, since 1952, Federal funds have been 19 20 taken into the State budget and are appropriated.
