

1 MR. DONAHO: There is no matter of public policy  
2 involved, right?

3 THE CHAIRMAN: What do you mean, there is no  
4 matter of public policy?

5 MR. DONAHO: Well, is there? Is there a matter  
6 of public policy, whether you build this addition or not?

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Well, that is for us to decide,  
8 I suppose, for the University to decide.

9 MR. PERKINS: The Board of Regents.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: The Board of Regents will decide  
11 that.

12 MR. DONAHO: Suppose the legislature doesn't  
13 like what you are going to do or the Governor doesn't like  
14 it?

15 MR. BROOKS: They are protected under the Autono-  
16 my Act.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: That's right.

18 MR. DONAHO: The Autonomy Act is possibly why,  
19 because the Constitution gives it to you, but the legislature  
20 could give you this.

21 MR. BROOKS: The legislature gave them that.
