1	MR. BOND: Will somebody tell me what the
2	formula is?
3	THE CHAIRMAN: There are two basic formulas,
4	MR. BOND: Can somebody summarize it?
5	THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Perkins, can you do it?
6	I used to be able to rattle this off. He wants to know
7	that the grants-in-aid formulas are.
8	MR. BOND: In other words, how is the money
9	established or the formula established?
10	THE CHAIRMAN: Let's see if I can explain it to
11	you this far, and then you can tell him what the formulas
12	are. The thing is financed under what we call an equaliza-
13	tion program which says
14	MR. PERKINS: Not any more.
15	MR. DONAHO: Equalization turned out to be dis-
16	equalization program.
17	THE CHAIRMAN: Well, you go ahead.
18	DR. SENSENBAUGH: It is roughly based on
19	. \$340 per pupil at this point. This is the big basic, and
20	it runs about, a sharing across the State of about forty
21	per cent.
