

1 THE CHAIRMAN: That doesn't mean a thing to
2 me. I'm sure it does to you, but --

3 DR. SENSENBAUGH; The local unit has to tax
4 itself 1.228.

5 MR. PERKINS: For educational purposes.

6 DR. SENSENBAUGH: If they can't make it, the
7 basic program on their assessment, the State puts in the
8 difference, you see, that's the 1.228, and if it does not
9 make \$340 per pupil.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: The 1.228 --

11 MR. PERKINS: It's approximately 1.8 per cent
12 per \$100. Now, you have to get these figures from the
13 records.

14 THE CHAIRMAN: In other words, your minimum
15 program is figured at \$340 times the number of students
16 in the County?

17 DR. SENSENBAUGH: Right. If you don't make
18 that 1.228, the State pays the difference. In other words,
19 suppose 1.228 brings Frederick County to \$150. Then what
20 is left over, the State will pay.
