

1 MR. PERKINS: Yes.

2 MR. DONAHO: And the Governor can arrive at his
3 own determination based upon these statistics?

4 MR. PERKINS: Exactly.

5 MR. DONAHO: When it comes to the legislature,
6 can the legislature through its staff resources or through
7 its own infinite wisdom apply a judgment as to the number
8 of pupils?

9 MR. PERKINS: That's right.

10 MR. DONAHO: And having applied that judgment
11 as to the number of pupils, can they then reduce the request
12 that is in the budget?

13 THE CHAIRMAN: They cannot, no.

14 DR. SENSENBAUGH: Well, you will have to be
15 sure that they are not killing people off, because there
16 are new students that --

17 THE CHAIRMAN: The answer to your question, it
18 seems to me, and I may be all wrong about this, but it would
19 seem clear, because by the time it gets to the legislature
20 it is no longer in the process of formulization. It has
