1	it with them. Fortunately, they do not fight us.
2	MR. SACHS: An issue has never been made of it?
3	MR. PERKINS: Well
4	MR. HOFF: Mr. Rennie has said they have always
5	been cooperative.
6	MR. PERKINS: That's right, they have been with
7	us,
8	DR. SENSENBAUGH: Once the Board acts on them,
9	it is the Governor's and the Budget Bureau's responsibilit
10	from there. We don't take them back after they are revise
11	for approval.
12	THE CHAIRMAN: I know you don't, but my point
13	is after the Budget Bureau has changed the formula, the
14	inputs in the formula after the State Board has acted on
15	the budget
16	MR. PERKINS: Right.
17	MR. SACHS: And reduced it.
18	THE CHAIRMAN: And reduced it, but you have
19	never gotten on your high horse and said, this you cannot
20	do?
21	DR. SENSENBAUGH: We have always resolved the
