restraint upon that constitutional grant of power through referendum.

That ties us directly into matter considered by the Committee at its last meeting. You will recall, then, we asked Dr. Loevy to reduce the thoughts of the Committee to writing and he has made available a third report or a report which bears the caption of Third Report, and is further captioned, Continuation. It really is a continuation of the first report and not particularly or directly related to the third report itself.

That third report is a matter which, I think, we ought to take some final action on as a committee. 12 The recommendation there is first of all that the new 13 constitution retain the concept already in the existing 14 constitution of having new basic units of government when 15 created submitted to the voters for their approval or dis-16 17 approval by way of referendum.. The reporter points out that this would apply only to the basic unit of government 18 and is not to apply to units of government such as the 19 port authorities, taxing authorities, pollution authorities 20 21 or any metropolitan governments composed of combinations
