1 of cities and counties. 2 I would like to have any comment that any member may want to make or any of the guests with respect to 3 that restriction upon the grant of authority to the Legislature from the constitution. 5 6 There being no comment, I am going to --7 MR. MILES: I missed you at one point about 8 pollution, health, et cetera. 9 THE CHAIRMAN: That the referendum will be 10 provided for in the constitution itself where new political 11 subdivisions are being created of a basic nature, but will 12 not require referendum and the creation of, let us say, 13 Baltimore Port Authority or Pollution Control or any 14 metropolitan combination of county and city. We will have 15 that taken care of elsewhere actually by way of referendum but not insofar as the, unless it is a basic unit. If it 16 17 becomes a basic unit, of course, it would be required to 18 be submitted to referendum. 19 MRS.
