1	it. I feel somewhat hesitant about interjecting my
2	notions without specific invitation, but you are talking
3	about a very important matter now that bears upon what yo
4	do hereafter. It is so relevant to what I came here for
5	I do feel I should express myself. I will try to do so
6	very briefly.

I had already said a moment ago, we are in a period of very rapid change, particularly conspicuous in urban areas.

That means to me, very briefly, that when you go to working with this problem of distributing responsibility and authority for decision making within your total State governmental framework, you should build in great flexibility. You can't state everything that is going to happen by any means.

As seems to me, it is extremely important that you build in flexibility. If you put restrictions in your constitution with respect to this or that unit of government having a veto, that tends toward inflexibilities.

Second, I am a little off the mark at the time, but I think it is relevant, the crucial thing in state
