

1 it. I feel somewhat hesitant about interjecting my
2 notions without specific invitation, but you are talking
3 about a very important matter now that bears upon what you
4 do hereafter. It is so relevant to what I came here for
5 I do feel I should express myself. I will try to do so
6 very briefly.

7 I had already said a moment ago, we are in a
8 period of very rapid change, particularly conspicuous in
9 urban areas.

10 That means to me, very briefly, that when you
11 go to working with this problem of distributing respon-
12 sibility and authority for decision making within your
13 total State governmental framework, you should build in
14 great flexibility. You can't state everything that is
15 going to happen by any means.

16 As seems to me, it is extremely important that
17 you build in flexibility. If you put restrictions in your
18 constitution with respect to this or that unit of govern-
19 ment having a veto, that tends toward inflexibilities.
