

1 anywhere the Legislature created or the political sub-  
2 divisions through inter-governmental relations created an  
3 inter-governmental authority separate and apart from either  
4 State or local governmental authority, to administer a  
5 single program, that giving that authority the power, it  
6 would supersede whatever classification system you have;  
7 so that there where you are creating a new authority, you  
8 could put together any combination of political subdivisions  
9 you want to regardless of how they overlapped the other  
10 classification system, which would then permit development  
11 of any kind of metropolitan single purpose or multi-  
12 purpose governmental function to be placed under a  
13 governmental authority.

14 Down that track, you would always have a  
15 third government actually administering the program set  
16 up. Under one or the other of these two alternatives,  
17 the Legislature could probably enact all the legislation  
18 desirable for political subdivisions less than a Statewide  
19 interest.

20 We discussed this with Mrs. Kostritsky,  
21 Mr. Benton, Mr. Andrews, and Mr. Boucher as far as the  
Baltimore situation is concerned. They feel this does
