there will be compulsory home rule of one form or another,
which ties in with what your conviction is, Mr. Miles,
and that it shall be by a broad grant, agein without the
definition. We are wrestling with this definition problem
now.

Before moving on to Dean Fordham, I would like

memorandum and report. Attached to it is a draft of constitutional language. It is captioned under Alternative Provision. You have more or less pointed up, Mr. Melvin, that rather than requiring a charter be adopted by a county, that the language could be changed somewhat. What provision are you making for cities?

MR. MELVIN: I hadn't directed my thoughts toward

that, because this apparently only applies to counties, this particular provision. I don't see why it couldn't also apply to cities.

THE CHAIRMAN: There would be no reason why it couldn't apply equally to one as the other or to any political subdivision?
