

1 report has already been acted upon by the Commission and said.  
2 there will be compulsory home rule of one form or another,  
3 which ties in with what your conviction is, Mr. Miles,  
4 and that it shall be by a broad grant, again without the  
5 definition. We are wrestling with this definition problem  
6 now.

7 Before moving on to Dean Fordham, I would like  
8 to ask, however, consideration of this aspect of Dr. Loevy's  
9 memorandum and report. Attached to it is a draft of con-  
10 stitutional language. It is captioned under Alternative  
11 Provision. You have more or less pointed up, Mr. Melvin,  
12 that rather than requiring a charter be adopted by a  
13 county, that the language could be changed somewhat. What  
14 provision are you making for cities?

15 MR. MELVIN: I hadn't directed my thoughts toward  
16 that, because this apparently only applies to counties,  
17 this particular provision. I don't see why it couldn't  
18 also apply to cities.

19 THE CHAIRMAN: There would be no reason why it  
20 couldn't apply equally to one as the other or to any  
21 political subdivision?
