

Chapter 10.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claim of King Brothers.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Comptroller be and he is hereby directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer to pay to King Brothers the sum of two hundred and forty-five dollars, being the amount incurred in printing the Equity Rules by order of the Court of Appeals of Maryland.

Issue warrant.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 11.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money for the purpose of making repairs and additions to the furniture of and procuring articles necessary for the use of the Executive Mansion.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sum of thirty-five hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be required, be and the same is hereby appropriated for the purpose of making repairs and additions to the furniture of and for procuring articles necessary for the use of the Executive Mansion.

Appropriated for repairs. &c.

Issue warrant.

Governor to make return.

Effective.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That his Excellency, Robert M. McLane, Governor of this State, be and he is authorized to have such repairs and additions made and to procure such articles as he may deem necessary for the use of the Executive Mansion; and the Comptroller is hereby directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer for such amount as the Governor may require; provided that the said sum shall not exceed in the aggregate the sum of thirty-five hundred dollars; and the Governor shall make return to the Comptroller of the amount expended, together with the vouchers for the same.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
