

Rent lien on
crops.

upon the faith of the crops to be grown, said rent reserved, and such advances made, shall be a lien on such crop or crops, which shall not be diverted by any sale made thereof by the tenant or by any administrator of a deceased tenant, or by the assignment of the tenant in insolvency, or by the process of law issued against the tenant, provided that at the time of the said renting the contract, under and by which the said advances are made, shall be reduced to writing, duly attested and executed by the said landlord and tenant; provided that the provisions of this act shall apply only to the counties of St. Mary's, Prince George's, Charles, Calvert, Anne Arundel and Dorchester.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 68.

AN ACT to amend the charter of "The Presbyterian Eye and Ear Charity Hospital," as incorporated by the act of eighteen hundred and eighty-two, chapter four hundred and ninety-three, by changing the name of said corporation unto the Presbyterian Eye, Ear and Throat Charity Hospital, and allowing an increase of the number of governors thereof.

Corporate powers.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the charter of the Presbyterian Eye and Ear Charity Hospital, a corporation incorporated by the act of eighteen hundred and eighty-two, chapter four hundred and ninety-three, be and the same is hereby amended by changing the name of said corporation into the Presbyterian Eye, Ear and Throat Charity Hospital, and that the number of the board of governors shall be prescribed by the by-laws of said corporation, said governors to be elected by the board of governors constituted by said charter and its successors, at such times and in such manner as it may determine.
