### Chapter 73.

AN ACT to repeal the sixth sub-section of chapter two hundred and sixty-seven of the acts of assembly passed at the January session, one thousand eight hundred and eighty, entitled "An act to add new section to the first article of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled 'Allegany county,' to be sub-titled 'Insane Asylum,' and to vest in the county commissioners of said county additional powers relating to the care of insane persons," and re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *And be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sixth sub-section of chapter two hundred and sixty-seven of the acts of assembly passed at the January session of one thousand eight hundred and eighty, entitled "An act to add new section to the first article of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled 'Allegany county,' to be sub-titled 'Insane Asylum,' and to vest in the county commissioners of said county additional powers relating to the care of insane persons," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

SEC. ... For the purpose of raising the necessary funds to purchase the land and erect the building or buildings provided for in the foregoing sections, the commissioners of said county are hereby authorized to issue coupon bonds of said county, in denominations not less than one hundred nor more than five hundred dollars, and to an amount not exceeding thirty thousand dollars; said bonds to bear interest at a rate not exceeding four and one-half per centum per annum, and to mature and fall due as follows, viz.:
