

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the judges of the circuit court, or one of them, and the judges of the orphans court of said county, or one of them, may, together, appoint some suitable person librarian of such public law library, and pass such orders for the government and regulation of such library as they may think proper.

Chapter 75.

AN ACT to protect partridges in Calvert county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That no person shall shoot, trap or in any manner catch or kill any partridges between the eleventh day of January, said day inclusive, and the first day of November each year, within the limits of Calvert county.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That any person violating the above section shall pay a fine of five dollars for each and every offence, to be recovered before a justice of the peace in and for said county, and to be applied to the public school fund of said county.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 76.

AN ACT to regulate the taking of oysters in the Potomac river.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That it shall not be lawful for any person to take or catch oysters in any manner whatever in the waters of the Potomac river unless he be a citizen of Maryland or Virginia, and shall have
