How construed.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That this act shall go into effect as soon as it is adopted by the State of Virginia, by an act of her General Assembly, and shall continue in operation until repealed or altered by either state.

SEC. 7. And be it enacted, That nothing in this act shall be construed in any way to impair, alter or abridge any rights which either state, or the citizens thereof, may be entitled to, either by, through, under or against the compact entered into between the States of Maryland and Virginia on the twenty-eighth day of March, seventeen hundred and eighty-five, or any existing law of either of the two said states.

## Chapter 77.

AN ACT to declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequest of Nancy Mattox, deceased, late of Baltimore county, of the sum of fifty dollars, to the trustees of Ward chapel in Baltimore county.

Sauction and approval given.

Effective.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sanction and approval of the General Assembly of Maryland be and the same is hereby given and declared to the bequest of fifty dollars by the said Nancy Mattox, late of Baltimore county, deceased, to the trustees of Ward's chapel in Baltimore county.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take

effect from the date of its passage.
