Chapter 86.

AN ACT to repeal sub-section one hundred and thirty, chapter one hundred and eight, of the acts of assembly passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to add an additional article to the Code of Public Local Laws, to be entitled 'Garrett County,' sub-title 'Wild Animals,'" and re-enact the same with amendments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section one hundred and thirty of chapter one hundred and eight of the acts of assembly passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to add an additional article to the Code of Public Local Laws, to be entitled 'Garrett County,' sub-title 'Wild Animals,'" be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Allowance how obtainable

SEC. 130. To obtain such allowance it shall be necessary for the person killing such animal to produce the head, skin or scalp of the same before some justice of the peace for said county, and at the same time make oath that the said animal was taken and killed within the limits of Garrett county, within twenty-five days before the production of the head, skin or scalp before the justice, and said justice shall thereupon give the person producing the same a certificate that such head, skin or scalp was produced before him, wherein he shall set forth the above mentioned oath; and it shall also be the duty of the justice to mark any such head, skin or scalp by cutting holes through the ear, to prevent any second allowance for the same.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
