SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the comptroller is hereby authorized and empowered to apportion to Frederick county its usual and proper portion of the school tax levy in the apportionment to be made by said comptroller in pursuance of law, on the fifteenth day of March, eighteen hundred and eighty-four, in the same manner as if the county schools of said Frederick county had been kept open seven and one half months during the year ending December thirty-first, eighteen hundred and eighty-three, any provision in the said act of eighteen hundred and seventy-two to the contrary notwithstanding.

AN ACT to add a sub-section to section fifty-four of article twenty-one of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington county," sub-title "Circuit court," as amended by chapter eighty-three of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, to provide for an additional common law term of the circuit court for Washington county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the following sub-section shall be added to section fifty-four of article twenty-one of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington county," sub-title "Circuit court," as amended by chapter eighty-three of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, so as to provide for an additional common law term of the circuit court for Washington county, said sub-section to be designated section fifty-four A.
