non jury term of said court, beginning on the first Monday of August in each and every year, to which no jurors shall be summoned, but to which process shall be returnable as at the other terms, and at which judgment in uncontested cases shall be entered, and other business transacted as at other terms not requiring the presence or aid of a jury.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take

effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 104.

AN ACT to change the name of the village of Mechanicsville, in Montgomery county, to Olney; and to change the name of Mechanicsville District Number Eight, or the eighth election district, to Olney District Number Eight, or the eighth election district of said county, and to designate the voting place thereof.

Name of village changed.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the name of the village of Mechanicsville, in Montgomery county, be and the same is hereby changed to Olney.

Name of district changed.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the name of Mechanicsville district number eight, or the eighth election district of Montgomery county, be and the same is hereby changed to Olney district number eight, or the eighth election district of said county, and that the voting place or polls thereof shall be held at Olney.
