

Chapter 105.

AN ACT to declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the purchase by the Vestry of Reisterstown Parish, in Baltimore county, from George Kephart, of certain tracts of land in said county, containing in the aggregate not more than twelve acres.

WHEREAS it has been represented to the General Assembly of Maryland that the vestry of Reisterstown parish, in Baltimore county, have purchased of George Kephart certain tracts of land in said county, and it is desired to obtain the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to such purchase; therefore—

Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland be and the same is hereby given to the purchase, in fee, by the vestry of Reisterstown parish, in Baltimore county, from George Kephart, of certain tracts of land in said county, containing in the aggregate not more than twelve acres, and which are described in three deeds, dated January the fifteenth, eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, July sixteenth, eighteen hundred and eight-one, April the sixteenth, eighteen hundred and eighty-three, and recorded respectively among the land records of Baltimore county in Liber J. B., No. 110, folio 350, etc.; in Liber W. M. J., No. 123, folio 585, etc., and in Liber W. M. J., No. 134, folio 196, etc.
