### Chapter 115.

AN ACT granting the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to a gift of six hundred dollars (\$600) from Henry Zimmerman to the trustees of the Woodsborough Methodist Episcopal Church of Frederick county, in the State of Maryland.

WHEREAS Henry Zimmerman, of Frederick county, in the State of Maryland, by his last will and testament, recorded among the records at Frederick county the twenty-first day of February, A. D. eighteen hundred and eighty-one, gave the sum of six hundred dollars to the trustees of the Woodsborough Methodist Episcopal Church of Frederick county and State of Maryland; therefore— Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sanction of the general assembly be and the same is hereby given and declared to the above-mentioned gift of the said Henry Zimmerman. Sanction given to gift.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.
