SUB-SEC. C. The said sheriff's official bond shall be responsible for the faithful payment of said money as hereinbefore provided, and shall be liable for any default in any duty herein required to be performed by him.

Chapter 120.

AN ACT to amend the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester county," sub-title "Cambridge," as amended and re-enacted by chapter two hundred and sixteen of the act passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and eighty-two, by adding an additional section, to be designated as section seventy-three, authorizing the commissioners of Cambridge to make a bonded loan of two thousand dollars.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the following section be and the same is hereby added to the corporate laws of the town of Cambridge, as amended and re-enacted by chapter two hundred and sixteen of the acts passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and eighty-two, being an act to repeal sections thirty-one to seventy-three inclusive of the Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester county," sub-title "Cambridge," and all acts amendatory thereto, and to enact the following section in lieu thereof, the section hereby added to be designated as section seventy-three :

SEC. 73. *And be it enacted,* That the said town commissioners be and they are hereby authorized to issue bonds, not to exceed in amount two thousand dollars, upon the faith of the property of said town, of such form and denomination as the said town commissioners may prescribe, bearing interest at the rate of six per centum per annum, payable semi-annually
